It's time once again to put aside some cattle for the Taroom Show store and prime cattle competition.

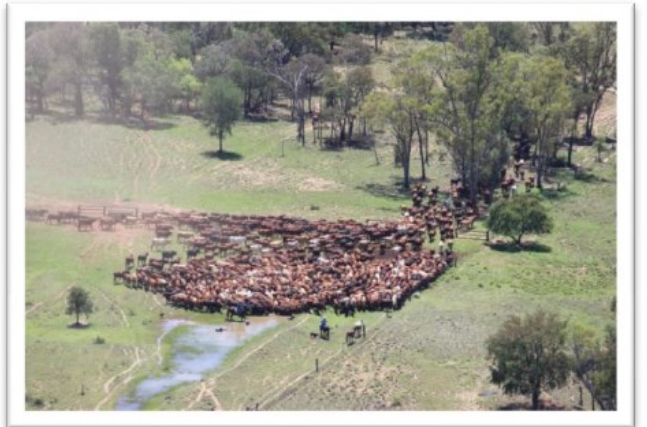
