

1. Chief Steward

- 1.1. The chief steward shall have final say in all decisions regarding any event and entrance into events. The chief steward has the ability to alter or remove any event in the Taroom Show schedule.
- 1.2. Any competitor or persons associated displaying disruptive or offensive behaviour at the discretion of the chief steward will be asked to leave the grounds immediately and excluded from participating in any further events at the Taroom Show.

2. Rider Safety & Waiver

- 2.1. All riders, inc competitors in led/handler classes, must sign a waiver before competing in the Taroom Show. Waivers are available at the secretary office. Once completed, riders will receive two coloured wrist bands to be worn on different days of the show. Stewards will ask all competitors to show their wrist bands before competing in an event.
- 2.2. Competitors ride at their own risk. Each competitor must acknowledge that it is a condition of acceptance of their nomination that the show society committee will not be responsible in any respect for injury, loss or damage, personally or otherwise which may be suffered by them in consequence of or in any way arising out of their attendance at or participation in the show. He/she must agree for themselves, their executors and administrators to indemnify the Taroom Show Society and its members in respect to any such claim.

3. Biosecurity

3.1. Taroom Showgrounds is biosecurity controlled. All horse owners entering the grounds must complete a Horse Health Declaration and deliver it to the show office before competing.

4. Nominations

- 4.1. Nominations will be by ticket system. A ticket to the value of the entry fee must accompany each nomination for each event. Without a ticket, competitors will be refused entry to the class.
- 4.2. Tickets will ONLY be available from the secretary's office.
- 4.3. Tickets still remaining at the completion of the show will become invalid if not presented for refund within <u>ONE HOUR</u> of completion of the final ring event.

5. Marshalling

- 5.1. Competitors are responsible for being ready for each scheduled event.
- 5.2. Stewards will call each class and write the next class on the ring blackboard. The ring announcer will also mention at different times the class presently being judged.
- 5.3. Competitors are asked to assemble outside the gate prior to the class and wait for the steward's call.

6. Height and Breed Related Classes

- 6.1. Pony: must not exceed 14hh.
- 6.2. Galloway: 14hh and not exceeding 15hh.
- 6.3. Hack: over 15hh.
- 6.4. Measuring of ponies and galloways will take place at a specified time before the show. Please see the secretary's office for time and location. A card stating height will be issued and must be available to be presented to the steward/judge in any event where the height is stipulated.
- 6.5. Breeding papers of all exhibits must be given if demanded by the judge or steward.
- 6.6. Proof of financial breed society membership may also be demanded by the judge or steward.

7. Other Definitions

- 7.1. Maiden: has not won a hack class in competition at an affiliated show.
- 7.2. Novice: has never won an open champion class at an affiliated show.
- 7.3. Intermediate: has not placed at a royal show
- 7.4. Open: open to any horse or pony.
- 7.5. Horse section competitors are either a Hunter or a Hack for the duration show. Exceptions to this rule are for ridden breed classes and local competitors, where local competitors can compete in either the open hack or hunter sections of the show and also participate on a Hack OR Hunter classified horse for local classes.
- 7.6. Competitors riding in the pony ring must be under the age of 17. Proof of age may be requested.

8. Local/District Classes

- 8.1. Local/district classes will be limited to horses/ponies that have been pastured within 100km radius of Taroom township for three months prior to the show.
- 8.2. Local/district classes will be limited to competitors that reside within 100km radius of Taroom township for three months prior to the show.

9. Protests/Disputes

- 9.1. In the event of a dispute, the rules of the Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies shall apply. "Any protest by an exhibitor must be lodged in writing with the committee person or steward in charge of any section within 30 minutes of the completion of the event together with a fee determined by the committee of this society. The fee will be forfeited if the protest is considered to be frivolous or vexatious. The protest shall be heard according to the rules of the natural justice by a dispute committee of three appointed by the president of this show and the decision by the disputes committee shall be final."
- 9.2. The determined fee for protests/disputes at the Taroom Show is \$50.00.

BIOSECURITY

Horse Health Declaration

All horses entering the Taroom Showgrounds must complete a Horse Health Declaration and be handed in at the show office. Forms are available at www.taroomshow.com.au or show office.

Cattle Tick Free Zone

The Taroom Show Grounds are a cattle tick free zone.

Before you move horses from the infested zone to the free zone you must be tick free and have met your cattle tick risk minimisation requirements.

You must read and follow the procedures identified in 16b of the Queensland biosecurity manual for the intended movement. There are 3 options provided in the manual that you can use to meet the requirements:

- 1 Owner manual inspection and chemical treatment
- 2 Owner manual inspection and manage your horse in a (tick free) stated way
- 3 Accredited certifier manual inspection and chemical treatment.

You also need to record on the movement record the actions you have taken to meet the requirements.
