Monday 7th - Tuesday 8th May 2018

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Taroom Show Society committee reserves the right to change or delete classes or rulings in the show schedule at any time before or during the show
- 2. Junior competitors can only compete in the junior jumping (Sunday) or Ring 2 events not both
- 3. Each horse can only have TWO starts on each day of the show
- 4. Rider waiver forms must be signed before competing
- 5. All nominations must be handed into the jumping steward during the course walk & before the class starts. Entries handed in after commencement of the class will not be accepted.

Riders must declare to the judge before competing if they will be riding for the Amateur/Young Horse/Both Incentive in that class.

Junior Riders:

- Athletes can take part in competitions for Juniors until the end of the calendar year, in which they
 reach the age of 18 years
- Athletes may take part in open competitions, 1.20m and above from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 12 years
- A Junior competitor may compete in Junior and Senior competitions on the same horse at the same event in National, State, jumping competitions, and agricultural shows UNLESS permission is denied in the schedule.
- In competitions with the word "Senior" in the title, (Example: Senior Championship, Senior Grand Prix, Senior Six Bar) athletes are eligible to compete from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 18 years.
- · Junior classes are special events that do not count for points.

Amateur Rider:

- Must not have competed in an Olympic Games or World Equestrian Games in either Jumping or Eventing
- In the past 10 years must not have competed in a World Cup for Jumping Riders qualifying round.
- Must not have competed in section 1 and 2 at a Royal Show in Sydney, Brisbane, Melbourne, Adelaide or Perth in the past two years
- Must never have competed in a 4* 3 Day Event.
- Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class if they compete in a class where the first round is higher than 1.20m at that show.
- Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class on a horse that will compete in any class where the first round is higher than 1.20m at that show.
- Athletes must be meet the membership requirements as set out in the EA General Regulations.
- Riders may compete as amateurs from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 21 years of age.
- Organisers may at their discretion limit the number of horses a rider can start.
- The course shall be free-flowing and relatively simple. The first obstacle in the first round should be 10cm lower than the advertised starting height of the competition.
- There will be a maximum height rise of 10cm for the jump-off.

Young Horse: Any horse 7 years or under
